Comments:

Throughput for the week was above budget, with more than 92,000 tonnes of sugarcane crushed.

The dry weather conditions are favourable for the harvesting and milling sectors, however some districts would benefit from top-up rain.

Average weekly CCS jumped again to 14.61 – slightly more than a full unit above budget. This has pushed the season-to-date CCS above 14 units for the first time this crushing season.

The highest CCS sample was 16.96 from a rake of third ratoon KQ228 in the Elaroo Productivity District.

Please remember to 'Use your train brain' and always take care around our cane rail network.

Be aware that, even after brakes are applied, cane trains require long distances to slow down and come to a complete stop.

The next major maintenance day is scheduled for Wednesday 18 August.
