Comments:

The weekly throughput of 74,000 tonnes was below budget due to a 24-hour planned stop on Wednesday 18 August.

Boiler repairs and other jobs scheduled for the major maintenance day were completed successfully. This allows a three-week break until the next maintenance day, tentatively scheduled for Wednesday 8 September.

Average weekly CCS was 14.61 – more than half a unit above budget, resuming its steady upwards climb following the previous week's rain.

The highest CCS sample was 16.90 from a rake of fourth ratoon Q183 in the Elaroo Productivity District.
