Comments:

The weekly throughput of 75,000 tonnes was below budget due to the requirement to shut down No. 3 boiler for necessary repairs. The boiler is scheduled to come back online this week.

CCS continues its steady climb upwards. Average weekly CCS was 14.95 – more than half a unit above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 16.95 from a rake of first ration KQ228 in the Gunyarra Productivity District.
