Proserpine Mill processed close to 54,000 tonnes of cane for the final week of the 2021 season, bringing the total season throughput to 1.56 million tonnes.

The last cane for the season was crushed just before 10pm on Friday 19 November.

Average weekly CCS dropped to 13.60 units, bringing the preliminary season CCS to 14.43 units.

The highest CCS sample was 17.23 from a rake of Second ratoon Q208 in the Gregory Productivity District.

I'd like to thank all growers and harvest contractors for their hard work and cooperation during the 2021 season.

I'd also like to recognise Proserpine Mill employees for their safe operations during the year.

I can't stress enough the need to continue using your 'train brain'. Although the crushing season is over, our maintenance crews will continue to operate around the cane rail network.
