Wilmar owns and operates all four of the sugar mills in the Burdekin – Australia's largest sugarcane producing region. The oldest of our Burdekin mills, Kalamia, was established in 1884. The other three mills are Invicta, Pioneer and Inkerman. Invicta Mill at Giru is one of Australia's largest sugar mills. Along with milling, we are also heavily invested in cane farming and renewable energy generation from biomass.
