Since 2011, when Wilmar purchased Proserpine Mill, we have invested heavily in the mill and the extensive cane rail network that carries sugar cane to it.

We are an Australian leader in agricultural bioindustry. Our mill produces raw sugar, molasses and renewable energy which is exported to the grid. We are also a major producer of bioethanol, bio fertiliser and liquid stockfeed.


