Wilmar continues to invest for a sustainable sugar industry in North Queensland.

Since 2010, when Wilmar purchased Sucrogen from CSR, we have invested heavily in our eight sugar mills, bioethanol distillery and the extensive cane rail network.

We are an Australian leader in agricultural bioindustry. Our mills produce raw sugar, molasses and renewable energy which is exported to the grid. We are also a major producer of bioethanol, bio fertiliser and liquid stockfeed.


